For the purposes of informing the discussion of one or more agenda items, the Chair of the meeting may invite councillors or non-councillors, who do not already sit on that committee, to participate in the discussion of specified agenda items, without the requirement for the meeting to close. With the exception of voting rights, their participation in any discussion to which they have been invited will be on the same basis as committee members, and follow the same Standing Orders for Rules of Debate at meetings (Standing Orders section 1)
