THE MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE PLANNING AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE HELD ON 13th JANUARY 2025

- 4. Public Question Time: There were no members of the public present
- 5. Declarations of Interest: There were no declarations of interest
- 6. <u>Minutes</u>: The Minutes of the meetings held on 9th and 19th December 2024 were taken as read and signed as being a true record
- 7. Matters Arising:
 - a. Notice Boards: Continue to monitor
 - **The Pound**: Continue to monitor
 Blind House: Continue to monitor
 War Memorial: Pursue offer of funding
 Action: **Clerk to arrange a site meeting Milestone by War Memorial**: Continue to monitor condition
 The Fountain: Repairs to the pointing completed at a cost of £250
 Viewing Platform: The cost of the work would be £1200 to remove damaged stones and replace with new and £1500 to remove the front damaged copings and replace with new

Money had been put in the budget for next year.

Information Board: On-going. Money to be put in the budget for three boards at a cost of £100 each plus frames.

- **c.** <u>**Bus shelters Wormwood Farm**</u>: It was agreed to ask for details of what work the lower quotation would entail so that the two quotations can be compared.
- d. <u>Rudloe No 2 site</u>: It was agreed to send a letter to Sarah Gibson MP to ask her to take up the issue of why the planning permission for this site is not being implemented

e. <u>Enforcement matters</u>:

Quarry Woods: The Enforcement Officer is chasing the Courts for a listing date. He has visited the site and documented that the Order still has not been complied with even though the building has been burnt to the ground

<u>Condensing Units – Londis</u>: The application had been refused. The Enforcement Officer has stated that the refrigeration and air conditioning units will

be relocated to the inside of the building. The works are scheduled to be completed by the end of February and the Enforcement Officer will check again at the beginning of March.

<u>Wormwood Farm</u>: Enforcement Officer investigating the change of use to a carpentry workshop and gym. A planning application had been submitted for this.

Letter received re a meeting with Corsham Town Council and the developers to discuss proposals for developing land on the B3109. It was agreed that five Councillors would attend from Box. The meeting will be held on 29th January at 5.34 pm

 - PL/2024/09222 Real World Studios, Mill Lane, Box Erection of 1.2m close boarded timber fence to western boundary of car park

Construction of new single storey front entrance extension and new rear single storey infill extension. Replacement of all existing roof finishes rainwater goods, windows and doors. PL/2024/11473 1 Princes Buildings, Barn Piece, Box T1 – Ash Fell Varying signs of Ash die back within the crown. The canopy is growing towards the buildings and has started to interfere with overhead cables

12. Neighbourhood Plan

One query that was raised was whether the Box Hill Common and the Community Orchard should be included in the Community Facilities or as Open Spaces. Clarification was also sought on what defines a Community Facility.
