Today the Box By Brook is central to leisure activities in today's village, offering abundant wildlife, riverside rambles and sports activities including trout fishing. It was not always like this. It was once at the heart of Box's manufacturing industries and local farming innovation. Discover which mills were recorded in the Domesday Book, why the church built a later medieval mill, and why one mill was called "half a mill".

- Appropriate footwear and clothing must be worn. If there has been recent rain, the footpaths could be very muddy in places.
