Blind House: Continue to monitor **War Memorial**: Letter received from a local business, who employs veterans, offering full funding to repair the War Memorial. However, it also states that it only has £1,000 to offer for initial repairs.

It was agreed that there would need to be a meeting on site to see if any work needs doing. The Clerk had asked for a quotations to restore the chains around the War Memorial.

Action: Clerk to arrange a site meeting

Milestone by War Memorial: Continue to monitor condition The Fountain: Repairs to the pointing completed at a cost of £250 Viewing Platform: The cost of the work would be £1200 to remove damaged stones and replace with new and £1500 to remove the front damaged copings and replace with new

Money had been put in the budget for next year.

Information Board: On-going. Money to be put in the budget for three boards at a cost of £100 each plus frames.
