4. Public Question Time: There were four members of the public present re planning application PL/2024/02617 A.H. Dodd & Co; Conversion of engineering factory to create two dwellings with an additional storey to No. 2 The Lycetts.

Three of the neighbours to the site raised concerns about access to the back of their properties for maintenance and as a fire exit.

The applicant stated that the neighbours have a statutory right to access the rear of their properties and this will not change. She stated that pre planning advice had been sought and it had been agreed that residential use for this site would be the most appropriate. The removal of the factory would reduce the number of cars and there would be five off street parking spaces created.
