6. Minutes: The Minutes of the meetings held on 9th and 26th September 2024 were taken as read and signed as being a true record

7. Matters Arising:

Bus shelters: A report on the condition of the bus shelters was received.
 The bus shelter by Wormwood Farm is in need of repair and may need reroofing.
 Clerk to obtain quotations to be considered with the budget.
 It was agreed that the Council does not glaze any of the windows in the remaining bus shelters

d. Enforcement matters:

Quarry Woods: Wiltshire Council's application to the High Court for committal for contempt of Court has been listed for Wednesday 23rd October **Condensing Units – Londis**: Application has been submitted

<u>Erection of wooden structure at Leafy Lane Woodlands</u>: An application had been submitted but was invalid as it needed an Ecology report. The Enforcement Officer will pursue this

<u>Large advertising sign on A4 Box Hill</u>: Letter received from the Enforcement Officer stating "no application for advertisement consent has been submitted and I take it that none will now be submitted unless you advise me to the contrary. The three poles of the unlawful advertisement remain erected. There will now need to be removed. I would request that within 14 days of the date of this email that you confirm in writing your intentions in this matter"

Post Minute note: Application for an advertising board has been submitted Wormwood Farm: Enforcement Officer investigating the change of use to a carpentry workshop and gym

e. Rudloe No2 Site: It was agreed that the letter received from the Planning Officer be forwarded to Corsham Town Council and the MoD Liaison Group

8. Correspondence:

a. New Government Planning Proposals: Report received from Wiltshire Councillors regarding the new Government's proposals to overhaul the planning system with a new National Planning Policy framework which could see an 81% increase in housing targets in Wiltshire. Wiltshire had been set at 3476 new homes annually – up from the current target of 1917 homes a year which the emerging Wiltshire Council Local Plan is based on.

The changes also propose the abolition of the four year Housing Land Supply and the proposals for the greenbelt, significantly weakening greenbelt protections and introducing the very vague and subjective concept of "greybelt"

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group are aware of the proposals.

- **Concerns from a parishioner**: Concerns about the Parish Council;s response to a planning application had been received and dealt with by the Council Chairman
- 9. Sale of woodland for parking Lower Kingsdown Road: Letter received from a resident expressing concerns about the fencing off or sale of woodland in Lower Kingsdown Road.

A letter had been received from the Golf Club stating: "At present no final decisions have been taken by the Golf Club in regard to the woodland off Lower Kingsdown Road.

We have been seeking expert advice on how best we can deal with the trees within the wood which have ash die-back and I am sure you are aware there is a significant financial cost to the felling which has led to the possible outcome to fence off land (except for the existing rights of way) as one possible outcome to assist in keeping the public safe from falling branches as much as possible. It is stressed that this is just one option, and no final decisions have been made.

We are also looking into selling off some areas along the road in an attempt to raise funds to pay for the tree works, these would be small parcels of our land for the purpose of providing a parking space for some of the residents who do not currently have parking with their property. Again no final decisions have been made.

In any outcome we will be keeping communications open with the residents before any works are undertaken."

In light of the above it was agreed that this is not a planning issue and the Parish Council cannot get involved.
